## SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION PROPOSITION KOSH SCHOOLS

Shall the Board of Education of the Oregon-Howell R-III School District, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) for the purpose of providing funds to replace the current asphalt parking lot with an asphalt overlay with fiber parking lot; to upgrade heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units as needed; to repair roofs; to the extent funds are available, complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof?
